- Easy to sail...very forgiving

- User-friendly cockpit, simple interior, easy rigging and low upkeep...ideal for the first-time sailboat buyer
- Excellent boat for day sailing, weekend family cruising, and Class and PHRF racing
- Four models built:
 - Original (1969-1985)
 - > New Design (1985-1994)
 - **MK-II** (1995-2010)
 - Sport (2004 to current)

Catalina 22 (Original) Introduced in 1969

The original Catalina 22 model, with over 13,000 hulls, was one of the most successful sailboats ever built.

Features:

- Available with swing and fin keel, most Catalina 22s are swing keels
- Optional pop-top for more interior room
- Easy to trailer
- Blade or kick-up rudder





Catalina 22 New Design

Introduced in 1985

A very solid boat for family cruising with over 2,000 hulls built through 1994.

New Features:

- Slightly longer and higher cabin trunk
- Dark tinted windows
- Forward hatch built into cabin trunk
- Galley moved forward
- Ice chest serves dual role as step and cooler
- Gas tank locker isolated from cabin
- Built-in anchor-well in bow
- Optional wing keel





Catalina 22 MK-II Introduced in 1995

A highly desired trailerable cruising boat and competitive club racer.

New Features:

- ✤ 8 inches more beam at the deck
- Tilt-up sliding cabin hatch
- More open interior room
- Slide-out galley
- Larger cockpit
- Keel is fiberglass encased (low maintenance)







A fun weekend sailor and a competitive Class and PHRF performer.

New Features:

- Wider side deck
- An even larger cockpit
- Inboard and outboard tracks
- Simplified Interior (no galley)
- Available with fiberglass encased swing keel only

- Catalina 22 Championship National Regattas held every year since 1972








Cruising


