



Catalina 22 Region 4
GRIN – Great Racing In the North Series
Rules



1. Eligibility – open to any Catalina 22 owner who is also a member of the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association. A Catalina 22 will automatically be eligible to compete for the GRIN award if the above requirement is met and competes in at least one of the following designated Catalina 22 Region 4 GRIN regattas:

Tune-Up Race Weekend, May 6 & 8

Eagle Creek Sailing Club, Indianapolis, Indiana

Throwdown in Motown Regatta/Region 4 Championship, August 26 & 27

North Star Sail Club, Lake St. Clair, Michigan

Grand Annual Regatta, September 23 & 24

Cave Run Sailing Association, Morehead, Kentucky

Old Fox Regatta, October 7 & 8

Alum Creek Sailing Association, Columbus, Ohio

2. Scoring – the scoring of each individual regatta shall be in accordance with that event's Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions. The scoring for the GRIN shall be as follows:
 - a. Each Catalina 22 shall receive a score for each designated GRIN regatta using the following formula: her finish position in the Catalina 22 fleet divided by the number of registered Catalina 22s in that fleet.
 - b. A Catalina 22 that does not compete in a regatta shall be scored 1.1 points for their GRIN score for that regatta.
 - c. There shall be no throw-out regattas.
 - d. The scores for the designed GRIN regattas shall be totaled and the Catalina 22 with the lowest total score shall be named Region 4 GRIN Champion.
